DETAILS OF THE 2011 HARVEST

The heavy rains in winter allowed the vines to withstand a drier cycle than it was expected. The warm temperatures during September and October, along with the absence of meteorological anomalies, allowed a longer harvest period which, in turn, enabled the optimum ripening of each plot.

HISTORY

"Malleolus de Valderramiro" is made with grapes from the Valderramiro vine plot. The three vineyards in this plot were planted in 1924. The yield from these vineyards is 2,500 kg / ha and this wine is true to the Ribera del Duero "terroir".





TASTING NOTES

The greatness of the 2011 vintage truly stands out in this singular "terroir", finding a direct link between the wine and the soil. The liquorish notes of an optimal ripe fruit dominate the aromatic palette along with notes of wood, oak, cocoa, tobacco... This wine offers a great opportunity to discover, through the wine itself, the greatness of our most exclusive vineyards.

WINEMAKING PROCESS

26 days of maceration in small capacity vats, malolactic fermentation in American oak barrels and ages in French oak barrels for 18 months.
